Applicable

Throughout the Cooperative's service area for qualifying members in accordance with the Rules of the Wyoming Public Service Commission and the Terms and Conditions of Service set forth in the Cooperative's Rules and Regulations on file with the Wyoming Public Service Commission.

Available

To all members for farm and domestic uses, except those accounts who are sub-metered, net-metered, or are participating in our opt-out metering option.

Type of Service

Single-phase, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltage.

On-Peak Time – The on-peak timeframe for this rate is 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Off-Peak rates will be charged 9:01 p.m. to 12:59 p.m. Monday through Saturday, all day on Sunday, and all day on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Adder

If a member elects to incur an additional charge for the purchase of "Renewable Energy," the charge will be \$0.003 per subscribed kWh, not to exceed total monthly usage.

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum charge shall be the highest of the following:

1. The distribution monthly grid access charge.
2. The contract minimum in accordance with the Cooperative's line extension policy.

Determination of Billing Demand (Non-coincident Peak Demand (NCP))

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the member for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.
